Dynamic duo puts the runs on the board again

The foundation was laid again by Isaac Hogan and Tom Meredith as they put the result beyond doubt against Highton at McDonald Reserve on Saturday.

Quickly becoming one of the finest opening pairs in the competition, Hoges and Tom knocked off 62 off the chase after **the 1sts** had restricted the Heat to 130 in a fine team bowling and fielding performance which included three run outs.

The win puts the Ones back in the top four and restores confidence after a run of three losses.

It was the 10th time Hogan and Meredith had opened the batting with only once failing to reach 20, In those 10 matches they have combined for 413 runs at 3.14 runs per over in 405 minutes together at the crease with 3 half century opening stands. Hoges has posted 384 runs for the season at 42.67 while Tom has 325 at 36.

Earlier in the afternoon George Chisholm with 2/25 and Jordan Tegelhuter 2/10 led with the ball, while Tegs completed his return to the big time with a run a ball innings of 25.

The 2nds complied a competitive 195 on KFC Oval with Wink Simson leading the way with 86 but this was chased down in the final over. Debutant Darcy Lang contributing 17 not and 1 for 50 from his 10 overs.

The 3rds did their best to snatch defeat from the jaws of victory losing 7 for 70 in the run chase of 132 to stagger to a two wicket win. Henry Brayshaw (3/22) did best with the ball while the veteran Adam Kalz topped scored with 36.

After an opening stand of 85 by Adrian Windt (47) and skipper Adam O'Connor (52) **the 4ths** settled for 152. 2020/21 club leading wicket taker Zac Stokes with 3/34 did best as the Heat was bundled out for 119. Windy enjoying his return to club cricket passed the 5000 run mark with the Two Blues in 151 matches at the remarkable average of 40.72.

The 5ths and 6ths rediscovered that premiership winning formula with comfortable wins. Craig Green and Adam Patching with 50 not apiece in the 5ths and Troy Logan (53 not in the 6ths) did best.

Fifth XI skipper Anthony Devlin chipped in with 18 runs opening the innings in his 499th club match. We will hear a bit more about Specs this week as we join to celebrate the club life member becoming the first Two Blue to reach 500 matches.

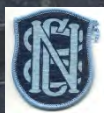

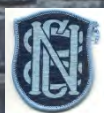

PLAYING straight and long was a plan that came off for Jordan Tegelhuter, who belted 174 runs in boundaries in a devastating knock for Newtown & Chilwell's seconds on Saturday.

Having recently been promoted up to the Second XI off the back of a pair of five-wicket hauls with the ball, Tegelhuter was also pushed up the order to open the batting.

After making 52 at better than a run-a-ball in the last game before Christmas, the right-hander took the Lara bowling line-up to task and smashed 198 runs off 106 balls, with 15 sixes and 21 fours.

"Everything just fell into place really, I was seeing them well and I had a bit of luck," he said.

"When you are given the licence to play your shots at the top it is pretty relaxing because you have plenty of blokes after you who can hold the innings together if you go early."

A four off the second ball he faced settled Tegelhuter's nerves and he was quickly "feeling pretty good".

"I tried not to get too far ahead of myself but when they just kept going to the fence it was hard not to think that way a bit," he said.

His celebration for his maiden ton was muted before Tegelhuter raised the scoring rate even further.

"I got my 100 with a six, so that was pretty good. And there were a couple over mid-wicket where even the fielders said 'Oh that has gone a long way'," he said.

Tegelhuter's monster knock

got his side to 6-359 from 50 overs and as Lara set about its chase, he wasn't keen to roll the arm over.

But the seamer claimed 3-17 to help seal the 137-run win.

"I was hoping I didn't have to bowl to be honest because I was pretty sore, not that I did a lot of running but I don't usually bat for that long," he said.

"I was a bit lucky, a couple of rank balls got wickets. I had to take myself off during the bowling because I was knackered."

Tegelhuter found a second wind to celebrate with his teammates and is now eyeing a return to the firsts for the Two Blues for the first time since the 2015-16 season.

"You always want to play as high as possible, so if I get given the chance I want to keep my spot," he said.
